

Your Council Needs You!

The Padron is the local Town Hall census that is carried out every year. The information gathered is used by Regional and Central Government to decide the level of subsidy to be allocated to each Town Hall Council. This subsidy is vital to each Council to ensure a continuation of essential services such as Medical Care, Ambulances, Social Services, etc.

You should register in person at your local Ayuntamiento office. You will need the following items:

- Passport
 NIE Certificate
- One of the following: House Deeds or Rental Contract Rates Receipt

Property Owner Authorisation

If you are Resident, the Padron is renewable every five years. If you are Non-resident then you need to renew every two years. The information you supply is not shared with any tax authorities.

Charity Cycle Ride

One of our members, Sean O'Reilly, recently completed a 150 km charity cycle ride from Cuenca to Madrid, part of the Pilgrimage Route to Santiago de Compostela.



Sean completed the three-day ride in February against strong headwinds and temperatures of -3 degrees. Not exactly conducive weather for biking 150 kms cross-country!

Sean has already cycled over 2,700 kms of the Pilgrimage Route. His next challenge is completing the part of the route from Madrid to Santiago, this June.

Sean raised €300 in sponsorship and he donated this to the U3A Charity Fund. He requested that the donation be given to the Franciscan Hospice in Gandia.

British Consul Brexit Meeting

At a recent, well-attended meeting at the Forum in Alfaz the British Consul for Alicante, Sarah-Jane Morris, laid out the post-Brexit rights which have already been agreed by the 27 EU Members.



For those British Nationals residing here for more than 183 days per year, she recommended that they should have Spanish Residencia. She stressed that for anyone here living 'under the radar' the position has not been agreed. After Brexit on 29th March 2019, it could be more difficult to obtain Residencia or exceed the allowance of 183 days per annum.

A local Solicitor has confirmed that the following documents are required to obtain a Residencia Certificate:

- · Original passport.
- NIE document.
- · Padron certificate.
- Title deed or rental contract
- UK S1 form for healthcare. If you do not have an S1 or any other health cover, you must provide your private health insurance policy.
- Bank account certificate showing that a minumum monthly sum of €650 is paid into your Spanish bank account.

The Consul confirmed that the UK State Pension for expats in Spain will continue to be increased each year in line with the UK. She also recommended that everyone should register on the local Town Hall Census (Padron). See Page 2 for more information.

Several issues were raised during the Q&A session, including voting rights for expats and the renewal process for UK passports. There will be another update meeting in the Autumn. The Consul recommended checking the following official websites for the latest news.
